- Background check guidelines



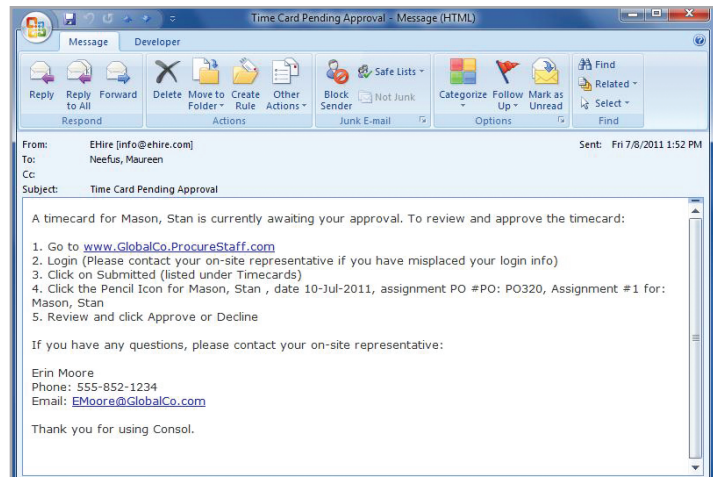

CONFIGURABLE AUTOMATED NOTIFICATIONS

Consol's list of up to 100 configurable notifications is complimented by an easy to use Program Configuration Wizard. Users can decide what delivery mechanism is best for them; they can choose email notification and/or dashboard alert. Notifications can be configured to alert program users of status updates and keep hiring managers aware of potential risks such as assignment end dates or upcoming tenure breaches. Notifications can also be sent to other groups within the organization who assist with the onboarding and offboarding processes, such as alerting Security of a new hire so they can create an employee badge or alerting IT that a new computer will be needed.

DECISION TREES
